Confirmation

Only chapters receiving written approval from the Director of Recognition Services will be allowed to sell merchandise at the International Convention. **Space is limited and no on-site applications will be accepted.**

Indemnity and Exclusion Clause

Neither the Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society, the Walt Disney World Swan and Dolphin Resort management nor any officers or staff members will be responsible for the safety or the property of the participants from theft, damage by fire, accident or other causes. Neither the Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society nor the Walt Disney World Swan and Dolphin Resort management will obtain insurance against any such damage, loss, harm or injury.
