Phi Theta Kappa chapters and regions are encouraged to publicly show gratitude to supportive alumni by nominating an alumnus for the Award of Appreciation. Nominations should provide specific examples of how the alumnus has supported the region or chapter through the key impact guidelines listed below. All alumni are eligible for nomination, regardless of affiliation with alumni associations or having previously received recognition for this award. Attendance at the PTK Centennial Catalyst 2018 is not required for nomination or consideration for the Award. Chapters and regions should nominate no more than one alumnus each annually. An Alumnus may be nominated more than once in the same year if separate nominations are submitted by the chapter AND the region. Submissions will be considered property of Phi Theta Kappa and may be used to promote alumni engagement.

- Lead fellow alumni in supporting the goals and projects of the region or chapter and its members through these key impact guidelines.
