Up to 10 Board of Trustees Awards may be presented each year. Each chapter may submit one entry for the Board of Trustees Award.

Award recipients will be notified in early Summer 2019. At least one Board representative is strongly encouraged to attend ACCT's Annual Leadership Congress in San Francisco, CA on October 16-19, 2019. All registration and travel expenses are the responsibility of the award recipients.
