My hobbies are anything dealing with water. Being a Florida native, I was practically raised around water. Fishing, kayaking, and paddle boarding just to name a few.



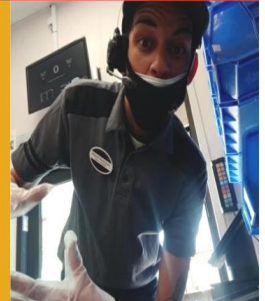
Out of high school, I did not necessarily come straight to college. I have worked in various leadership roles from Shift Manager to Regional Training Manager. Being a leader is my forte.
